FAQ

- All players must have a USA Lacrosse membership. This membership is nationally required by all youth lacrosse organizations. You only need a player registration; you do not need a parent membership. The cost for membership is \$35.**
- Registration for the K – 2nd grade team is \$100.**
- Registration for 3rd – 8th grade is \$150.**
- We provide all protective equipment for new players (or players who do not have their own). This includes a helmet, chest protector, elbow pads and gloves.**
- Players need to provide their own lacrosse stick. You can purchase them locally at Dick's, Academy, Play It Again Sports and Dunham's. You can also find them on Amazon and several other on-line stores. For a beginner you will be looking at around \$45. Please make sure you purchase a men's lacrosse stick, even if you are registering your daughter. You will also want to get a couple of lacrosse balls so your player can work on stick skills at home too.**
- Players will get a reversable game jersey with their name on it that is theirs to keep after the season.**
- Practices are on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays at Alamance Community Park from 6:30pm to 8pm for the 3rd – 8th grade teams.**
- K – 2nd will practice on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:30pm to 7:30pm. Practices will start in mid January.**
- The season will run from mid-January to early May.**
- All games are scheduled on Saturdays around the Triad area. If there is a cancellation due to weather the league will try to make up the games on Sunday.**
